

## **Playground rules**

Playground monitors will be assigned to the playground before school at the time students may arrive as noted in the student handbook and during all scheduled recesses. There will be no monitors after school or at extracurricular activities. All school staff, including the assigned monitors have full authority over anyone on the school grounds at any time and all school rules will be enforced.

### **Help everyone enjoy recess time.**

No rough treatment, name calling or foul language allowed.

Be careful of others. Always watch where you are going. Wait your turn.

Touch football only. No tackling. Touch tag is appropriate, but no pushing, shoving, wrestling, holding other people, or dragging each other by clothes. No take away games.

### **Use all play ground equipment as intended.**

No tag or chasing games on equipment.

Merry-go -Round use if overcrowded (K-2 A.M. Recess- 3-4 P.M. Recess). No dragging feet on the Merry -go -Round, stop it to get on and off. You can not jump off of it.

Go down slide on your bottom. No running, jumping, or climbing on slides. No putting things down the slides, like snow or toys.

No double swinging, swing straight, sit on your bottom, and no jumping out of swing.

Only one student on each end of the teeter-totter.

No hanging from or jumping at basketball nets.

### **Safety rules**

No playing in the shrubs by the fire hall or climbing trees. No playing with sticks.

Use the sidewalk when going to recess or lining up. No running behind the annex. No running out of the door when leaving the building.

No personal toys on the playground.

Unless approved by staff member, play with students 1 grade above or 1 grade below your grade for K-4.

No throwing rocks or snow. You need snow boots to go off the cement.

No re-entering the building or leaving play area without permission from an adult.

No jumping off the wall.

If you take your coat off, leave it in the upper playground area or you will be asked to line up early.

Breaking the rules will mean time on the wall or other discipline.
